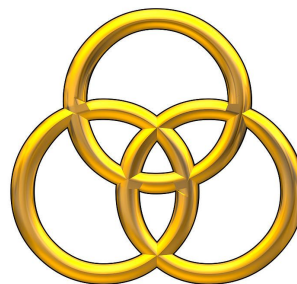

 God the Holy Spirit - the power of God which is active in the world, drawing people towards God.



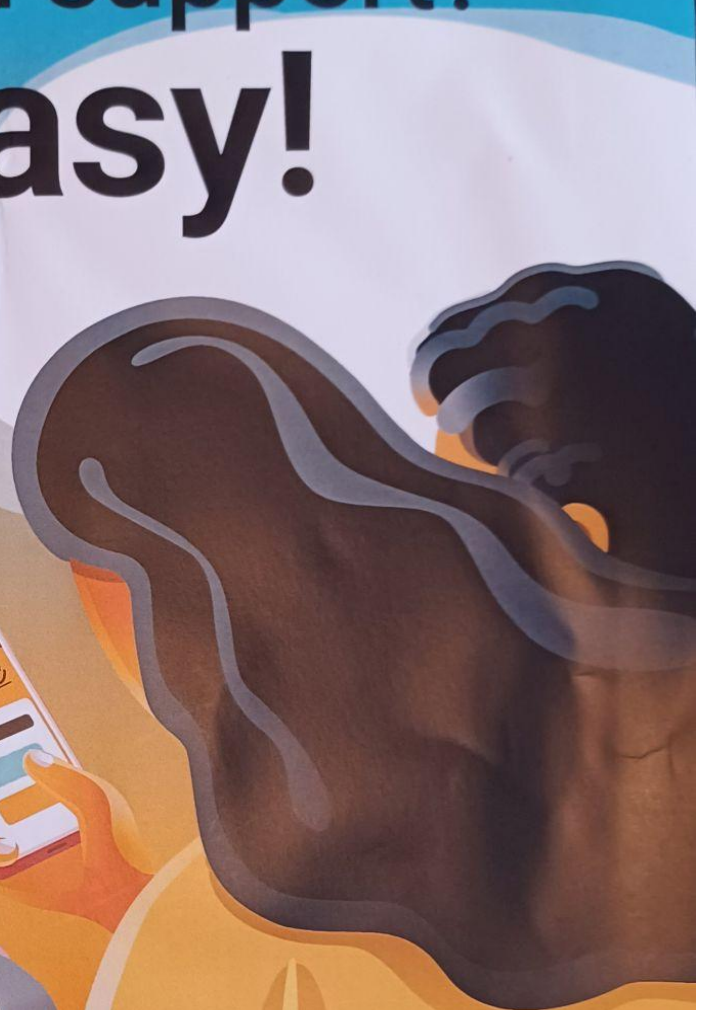
