We are giving you advanced notice to enable you to make alternative arrangements for your students for the Monday as there will be no school for them.



Palm Sunday -We remember Jesus coming into the city of Jerusalem on a donkey (9.30 am Mass) Thursday - We remember the gathering of the disciples and Jesus in the upper room for the Passover which we now know as the institution of the Eucharist (or the first Mass). (7pm Mass) Friday - We remember the walk of Jesus to Calvary where he was crucified. (3pm Liturgy) Saturday - Easter Vigil - The evening of preparation for the Resurrection (7pm Mass) Sunday - Easter Day - The beginning of Easter Octave - celebrating the Resurrection of Jesus (9.30am Mass)

All families are welcome to come to any of the Easter liturgies with your children. Come along and journey with your Parish the most significant week in human history.


